RULES, REGULATIONS, & POLICIES

GENERAL RULES

- If you have questions about holidays or closings due to the weather, check the website. All announcements will be posted there. www.greenville-gymnastics.com
- Acceptable attire includes leotards and athletic wear (no zippers or baggy clothing).
- If possible, hair must be pulled back in a ponytail.
- Please, no jewelry or gum.
- Leotards with skirts not recommended for classes Beg I and above because of the danger they pose on the bars.

TUITION

Preschool (45 minutes weekly)	\$35.00/month
BegI/BegII Gymnastics (1 hrs. 15 min. weekly)	\$40.00/month
Tumbling (1 hr. weekly)	\$35.00/month
Additional Class	\$20.00/month
Level 3 – 6	\$70.00/month

- Tuition in any class is due and payable by the **10th** of the month.
- Neither student absences nor holidays reduce tuition.
- Because our bookkeeping has been computerized, if tuition is not paid by the 20th of the month, the computer will kick out a friendly reminder of your past due account. Upon your personal request, we will be glad to mail regular monthly statements.
- Because there is a waiting list for every class offered, if a registered student does not attend for one month with no notice or no payment, that student's spot can be taken without notice. If a student wants to keep her spot during a month she will not attend, her tuition must be paid by the 10th of the absentee month. Of course, it is always appreciated for you to let us know as soon as possible if reasons require you to withdraw.

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE

- Out of concern for the safety of your children and others, I am asking that no child report to class more than 10-15 minutes early and that every child be picked up promptly at the close of his/her class. Many parents may not realize that if one class ends at 6:15, the next class starts at 6:15. Because of the tight schedule, it is impossible to watch students who are waiting to be picked up.
- Each student will be allowed 1 makeup day per session (Fall, Summer, and Spring). If an absence is to be made up, there must be prior notice and the makeup must be scheduled through the instructor to avoid class overload.
